East Yorkshire Foodbank opened in May 2016 to give people in crisis hope, practical help and a brighter future. We value all of our supporters who make a big difference.

We provide three days' emergency food and support to local men, women and children in crisis. In 2020/2021 we gave out food to cover 82,500 meals. Our vision is to ensure that no-one in East Yorkshire suffers hunger.

Food Donations

Our food is generously donated by people in the local community (schools, businesses, churches and individuals). Volunteers of all backgrounds help to sort, pack and distribute food parcels to individuals and families in need. Local people are feeding local people.

Frontline Care Professionals

Families and individuals who come to us have been referred by care professionals. Social workers, health visitors, school liaison officers and others work with us to help people in crisis so that they do not have to go hungry.
